


LUSAKA PROVINCE

2010 Census Final Population and Electoral Information

Population Size

The population of Lusaka Province as captured during the 2010 Census of Population and Housing was 2,191,225. The population in rural areas was 336,318 and 1,854,907 in urban areas.

The population for Lusaka Province grew at an average rate of 4.6 percent per annum during the inter-censal period 2000-2010. Lusaka District was the fastest growing district with an annual rate of population growth of 4.9 percent, followed by Kafue District at 4.2 percent per annum and Chongwe District at 3.4 percent. Luangwa District had the least annual rate of population growth at 2.5 percent per annum.

Population Composition

Of the total population in the province, 49.4 percent (1,082,998) were males and 50.6 percent (1,108,227) were females. There were more males than females in rural areas and more females than males in urban areas. Rural areas had 50.4 percent (169,604) males compared to 49.6 percent (166,714) females, while urban areas had 50.8 percent (941,513) females compared to 49.2 percent (913,394) males.



Population Distribution

Of the 2,191,225 total provincial population, 15.3 percent (336,318) were in rural areas and 84.7 percent (1,854,907) were in urban areas.

At district level, Lusaka District had the largest percentage of the total provincial population with 79.7 percent (1,747,152). Kafue District was second with 10.4 percent (227,466), while Chongwe District was third with a population of 192,303, representing 8.8 percent of the provincial population. The district with the least of population in the province was Luangwa District with 1.1 percent (24,304).

Population Density

In 2010, the population density for Lusaka Province was 100.1 persons per square kilometre. The population density increased from 63.5 persons per square kilometer in 2000 to 100.1 persons per square kilometer in 2010, representing an increase in density of 36.6 persons per square kilometer.


The most densely populated district in the province was Lusaka District with a population density of 4,853.2 persons per square kilometre. This was followed by Kafue District with 24.2 persons per square kilometre and Chongwe District with a population density of 22.2 persons per square kilometre. Luangwa District had the lowest population density of 7.0 persons per square kilometer.

Household Size and Composition

The total number of households in Lusaka Province as captured during the 2010 Census of Population and Housing was 444,418. Male headed households made up 79.6 percent (353,797) of the total number of households, while female headed households made up 20.4 percent (90,621).


Total Number of Households and Sex of Household Head, Lusaka Province, 2010



Green National Registration Card (NRC) Holders by District

All Zambian citizens qualify to obtain a green National Registration Card (NRC) upon attaining the age of 16 years. In Lusaka Province, Luangwa District had the highest proportion of NRC holders with 86.4 percent, followed by Kafue District with 86.1 percent. Lusaka District had the least proportion of NRC holders with 84.8 percent.

Percentage of Population and Older with an NRC at the time of the Census by District, Lusaka Province, 2010




Electoral Information

At the time of 2010 Census, Lusaka province had 1,107,167 persons aged 18 years and above. These were eligible voters in the province. Of these, 631,816 were registered voters at the time of the census.

Lusaka District had the highest percentage of registered voters at the time of the census with 80.7 percent (509,837). Kafue District was second with 10 percent (63,465) of all registered voters in the province at the time of the census. Luangwa District had the least percentage of registered voters at 1.3 percent (7,912).
