



Population Size

The population of North Western Province as captured during the 2010 Census of population and housing was 727,044. The population in rural areas was 563,061 and 163,983 in urban areas.

The population for North Western Province grew at an average rate of 2.2 percent per annum during the inter-censal period 2000-2010. Kasempa District was the fastest growing district with an annual rate of population growth of 3.0 percent, followed by Mufumbwe District at 2.8 percent per annum and Kabompo District at 2.6 percent. Ikelenge District had the least annual rate of population growth of 0.4 percent per annum.

Population Composition

Of the total population in the province, 49.3 percent (358,141) were males and 50.7 percent (368,903) were females. There were more females than males in both rural and urban areas. Rural areas had 50.7 percent (285,558) females compared to 49.3 percent (277,503) males, while urban areas had 50.9 percent (83,345) females compared to 49.1 percent (80,638) males.



Population Distribution

Of the 727,044 total provincial population, 77.4 percent (563,061) were in rural areas and 22.6 percent (163,983) were in urban areas.

At district level, Solwezi District had the largest percentage of the total provincial population with 35.0 percent (254,470). Mwinilunga District was second with 14.3 percent (104,317), while Kabompo District was third with a population of 92,321, representing 12.7 percent of the provincial population. The district with the least share of the population in the province was Ikelenge District with 4.5 percent (32,919).

Population Density

In 2010, the population density for North Western Province was 5.8 persons per square kilometre. The population density increased from 4.6 persons per square kilometer in 2000 to 5.8 persons per square kilometer in 2010, representing an increase in density of 1.2 persons per square kilometer.

The most densely populated district in the province was Ikelenge District with a population density of 14.0 persons per square kilometre. This was followed by Solwezi District with 8.4 persons per square kilometre and Chavuma District with 8.2 persons per square kilometre. Mufumbwe District had the lowest population density of 2.8 persons per square kilometer.



Household Size and Composition

The total number of households in North Western Province as captured during the 2010 Census of Population and Housing was 130,803. Male headed households made up 76.3 percent (99,754) of the total number of households, while female headed households made up 23.7 percent (31,049).


Total Number of Households and Sex of Households Head, North Western Province,



Green National Registration Card (NRC) Holders by District

All Zambian Citizens qualify to obtain a green National Registration Card (NRC) upon attaining the age of 16 years. In North Western Province, Kasempa District had the highest proportion of NRC holders with 85.4 percent, followed by Ikelenge District with 84.8 percent. Solwezi District had the least proportion of NRC holders with 81.5 percent.

Percentage of Population 16 Years and Older with an NRC at the time of the Census by **District, North Western Province, 2010**




Electoral Information

At the time of the 2010 Census, North Western Province had 293,285 persons aged 18 years and above. These were eligible voters in the province. Of these, 211,765 were registered voters at the time of the census.

Solwezi District had the highest percentage of registered voters at the time of the census with 31.2 percent (65,973). Mwinilunga District was second with 15.4 percent (32,587) of all registered voters in the province. Ikelenge District had the least percentage of registered voters at 5.4 percent (11,341).
