The ISI is a professional society, established in 1885, with individual and institutional members in over 150 countries. Its objective is:

• to promote the understanding, development and good practice of statistics worldwide.

The ISI family includes the following seven Associations that focus on specific sub-fields of statistical science:

- International Association for Official Statistics (IAOS)
- International Association for Statistical Computing (IASC)
- International Association for Statistical Education (IASE)
- International Association for Survey Statisticians (IASS)
- International Environmetrics Society (IES)
- International Society for Business and Industrial Statistics (ISBIS)

### INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR OFFICIAL STATISTICS (IAOS)

IAOS is an association founded in 1985. It is an international non-governmental organization (NGO), which was created and developed as a specialized section of the International Statistical Institute (ISI). It is thus an Association of physical and legal persons who have scientific or professional interest in the field of official statistics. IAOS brings together producers and users of official statistics. It is run by an Executive Committee elected for a period of two years. The objectives of IAOS are:

- to promote the understanding and advancement of official statistics and related subjects.
- to foster the development of effective and efficient official statistical services, particularly in developing countries.

#### ISI REGIONAL STATISTICS CONGRESSES

The ISI Regional Statistics Conferences (RSC) serves as a platform to promote statistics and the ISI in different parts of the world. The first RSC was organised in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in November 2014 and the second one in Bali, Indonesia from 21-24 March, 2017.
